THE YEAR IS NEW AND SO ARE WE

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

Pershing

Equipped with a swim platform and plenty of couches, the yacht is ideal for sunny days spent at sea.


Custom line succeeded to embody all these features in its new models and projects which will set new standards in the market.



Sir Elton John entertained international guests with his solo piano concert performing his most celebrated songs like "Candle in the wind", "Rocket Man", "Daniel", "Bennie and the Jets", "Crocodile Rock", "Circle of Life", "Your song" and some hits of his last album "Wonderful Crazy Night" amongst which the opening song "Blue Wonderful".

After an hour and a half of playing the British star received rapturous applause from the 1,000-plus guests assembled on Quai Louis II and from the terraces of the Yacht Club, a building designed and built by his compatriot, Sir Norman Foster.He left the stage for the sea aboard his Riva, to a resounding salute as all the yachts in the Yacht Club's Marina sounded their horns, a fitting tribute for someone who is passionate about yachts.

"Blue Wonderful" marked the opening of "Private Preview" gathering, an annual opportunity for Ferretti Group boat owners in Monte-Carlo to visit and try out new boats in the fleet which this year included six world premières: Ferretti Yachts 850, Ferretti Yachts 450, Pershing 5X, Rivamare, 76' Bahamas and Custom Line Navetta 37.

FERRETTI GROUP AT THE CANNES YACHTING FESTIVAL 2016 WITH THE LARGEST FLEET OF THE SHOW, PRESENTING THE GREATEST NUMBER OF WORLD PREMIERES, 6 NEW MODELS FROM 12 TO 37 METERS.

Ferretti Group inaugurated the 2016 - 2017 season at the 39th edition of the Cannes Yachting Festival with its fleet of 22 yachts from 8 to 37 meters, amongst which presenting to the public 6 world premieres of Ferretti Yachts, Pershing, Riva and Custom Line brands:

- Yachts Ferretti 450 and Ferretti Yachts 850;
- Pershing 5X;
- Rivamare and the convertible 76′ Bahamas for the brand Riva;
- Navetta 37, the Group's flagship and the largest semi-displacement boat ever built by Custom Line.

The boat show in Cannes, the season's first major international event for the entire yachting industry, was opened with the annual press conference held by the Group, a tradition held year after year. Mr. Alberto Galassi, CEO of Ferretti Group, together with the Chief Commercial Officer of the Group, Stefano de Vivo, presented the main results achieved by the Group during the first eight months of 2016, confirming its global strategy for growth and investment.

In the first eight months of the year Ferretti Group continued its further market penetration internationally. In terms of consolidated order intake divided by geographies, as of the 31st of August 2016, the area including Europe, the Middle East and Africa accounted for 48% of new orders, while the Americas for 34% and the Asia Pacific markets for 18%

In addition to the six world premieres, the fleet consisted of:

- Ferretti Yachts 550, Ferretti Yachts 650, Ferretti Yachts 700 and the Ferretti Yachts 960 flagship;
- Pershing 62, Pershing 70, Pershing 82 and the maxi coupe Pershing 108;
- Itama 62′;
- Iseo, Aquariva Super, 63 'Virtus, 88' Florida and 88' Domino Super of Riva;
- Dolphin 74' of Mochi Craft;
- Navetta 28 of Custom Line.

Sea Pros was present on the Ferretti Group Booth to serve the Middle Eastern clients and assist them with the adequate knowledge and services on all brands represented. Major players in pleasure yachting gathered during this show to launch the season by showcasing their new worldwide models. Also, The vieux Port and The Port Pierre Canto hosted international exhibitors and boating enthusiasts in an incomparable fascinating setting where almost 600 boats were displayed on water and on land, hundreds of world premieres and a new space created for luxury: La terrace situated at the rooftop of the Palais des Festivals exclusive for the stakeholders of the luxury industry and for high-end servicing.



EXTERNAL DESIGN

Born from the collaboration between Officina Italiana Design, the firm headed by Mauro Micheli and Sergio Beretta, sole designers of the entire Riva fleet, along with the Ferretti Group Engineering Department and Strategic Product Committee, Rivamare is 11.88 metres (39 ft) long, with a full beam of 3.5 metres (11.6 ft).

With its sinuous and sleek lines, the new model looks seductive and sporty as soon as you set your eyes on it. Proposed in Ice White gel coat, Rivamare is available in all the colours of the Riva range, including in stunning London Grey, the exclusive metallic version much-loved by Riva owners.

Its side view reveals the striking angles of the keel and bow, ready to fly across the water.

Fitted at the sides of the anchor and stainless steel prow is a pair of night-time mooring lights: this is just one of the many details borrowed from previous models and a sort of tribute to the Riva tradition.

The boat's profile has a distinctive double-curved laminated crystal window at the level of the cabin. The most eyecatching feature on the deck is the windscreen, consisting of 5 double-curved laminated crystal glass sections set in a stainless steel frame, fitted with a rail for the cockpit cover.

The deck, in gloss varnished mahogany panelling, is enhanced by a central glass pane - set in a stainless steel frame - that boosts the natural light in the interiors.

A striking feature at the centre of the deck is the casing in chrome plated aluminium alloy supporting the signal horn, yet another stylistic element inherited from the Sarnico boatyard tradition.

This magnificent object, with its timeless look, completed by a mahogany shaft for hanging the Riva banner, is reminiscent of the fittings found on the old Riva speedboats, and is bound to become the distinctive hallmark of the new model. At the stern, both bulwarks feature striking grilles in polished stainless steel: a choice of style that displays a family feeling with the most recent coupés, like 76' Perseo.

EXTERIOR DESIGN

The stern features a major innovation, offering the luxury of a beach area.

The hatch, with inbuilt mahogany steps, in fact swings

open to reveal a large surface. Using the inclination of the stern and the level surface of the beach area, two specially designed ergonomic sun pads can be positioned over the hatch, offering the opportunity to experience the sea in a unique style.

With the hatch still open, more steps appear, complete with two storage compartments at the sides.

Upon request, the compartment on the starboard side can be enlarged in order to store a Seabob.

The beach platform is completed by the fender bar with a mahogany top. The stainless steel boarding ladder is housed beside the hatch. An underwater lighting system can be installed upon request. Past the two sundecks separated by a central walkway, we reach the cockpit.

It is furnished with a large C-shaped sofa set around the folding table in mahogany and stainless steel. This space, featuring numerous technical compartments as well as storage compartments for guests, can be protected by a retractable electro-hydraulic bimini top.

Situated behind the helm station are two furniture units



which, in addition to holding the structure of the pilot and co-pilot seats, can also be used as a cocktail preparation area. Both have an upper hatch with a mahogany top and stainless steel frame. Inside them, we find a washbasin, a Corian cutting board, a pull-out drawer for the bar set and glasses and a drawer refrigerator in the left hand cabinet, and in the unit on the starboard side an ice dispenser as well as two useful baskets for separate waste collection.


The pilothouse design draws inspiration from the driver's cabin in sports cars: the entire control panel is in carbon fibre with the frame lined in technical fabric. In addition to two handle bars in polished stainless steel and mahogany, it is embellished by other rich details, including the name of the model and serial number, both in chrome plated steel.

The helm station is worthy of a yacht: as well as the pilot and co-pilot seats, there is a third seat on the starboard side. Custom-designed for Rivamare by Officina Italiana Design, these seats feature a boat-coloured frame, upholstery in technical fabric and other refined details also found in the most recent Riva models.

Finally, on the left side of the windscreen is once again the search light, a hallmark of the Aquarama and Aquariva Super models, showing the close continuity between Rivamare and these past and present icons.

INTERIOR DESIGN

In terms of the use of interior spaces, the engineers and designers have created a masterpiece: a luxurious open space consisting of a kitchen, a bathroom with separate shower, and a living area in the bow that converts into a double bed.

Moreover, two of the three steps leading down from the cockpit fold back towards the stern and align with the top step, so that the whole area can be used to the best advantage. The standard wood finish proposed by the boatyard is rift cut white veneer, but the first six boats have been realized in gloss varnished mahogany in order to celebrate this unique event.

The kitchen has a Corian worktop, a sink, a refrigerator and a microwave oven. An ice maker can be added on request. Wall cabinets with leather-lined doors complete the interior design of an elegant and functional kitchen.

Two skylights, in the kitchen and bathroom ceilings re-

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spectively, provide perfect air circulation.

Crockery, glasses and the coffee maker are stored in a tall cabinet with pull-out mahogany shelves, positioned opposite the kitchen. Situated in the lower compartment is the boat's electrical switchboard.

The design of the dinette is dominated by a large sofa moulded around the shape of the bow. Stored inside a central locker is a pull-out board which turns it into a double bed. A TV can be installed on the bulkhead of the bow upon request. To complete the furnishings, it is possible to add an instant refrigerator for Magnum bottles, hidden by a top. while the double blind - daytime and blackout - provides a screen over the large skylight.

The entire lighting system, run on LED lights, is controlled through chrome-plated switch covers, personalized with the Riva Iogo.

There are also plenty of lockers, finished in polished fibreglass, located in the bilges.


CUTTING-EDGE PROPULSION SYSTEMS. ENHANCED PERFORMANCE AND ADVANCED FUNCTIONS

Rivamare is equipped with a pair of D6 400 DPH Volvo Penta engines (stern driven propulsion), each generating 400 Mhp at 3,500 rpm, with integrated trim control provided by a stern drive and interceptor management system. In terms of performance, the boat can reach a cruising speed of 31 knots and a maximum speed of 40 knots (preliminary data). The integrated control system, inclusive of Joystick and docking mode functions, makes it extremely easy to manoeuvre in narrow waters, as in sideways-mooring for example, thanks to the movement achieved by the combined use of the propellers. The driving mode function, available on request, enables Rivamare to be piloted exclusively through the joystick. The advanced autotrim function optimizes the trim while accelerating and steering, with combined action on the stern drives and interceptors.

The interface is a 7 inch or - on request - up to 16 inch 16:9 display touch screen, which operates alongside the traditional analogue instrumentation, combining the engine monitoring and navigation functions.

Performance also means comfort: upon request, it is possible to install an air-conditioning system in the lower deck and helm station and, for the first time on a boat this size, a Seakeeper NG5 stabiliser to minimize rolling motion when at anchor

All in all, Rivamare is an exciting Riva painting, successfully drawing on the past while stretching out to reach the future. With outstanding features and a noteworthy performance, Rivamare is the new TIMELESS! SP

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




THE "GENERATION X" PERSHING WORLD DEBUT

THE NEW 5X COUPÉ ... A PERFECT FUTURE ANTICIPATION

The Pershing 5X is the result of a collaboration between Ferretti Group's Engineering Department, Product Strategy Committee, and Fulvio De Simoni Design Studio, founded by the architect of the eponymous studio. The coupé represents a new, astonishing chapter in the 30-year history of Pershing.







EXTERIOR DESIGN

With a length of 54,2' (16,51 meters) and a maximum beam of 14.4' (4.38 meters), the Pershing 5X is a yacht with super sporty lines. The aerodynamic design of the super-structure is further enhanced by distinct stylistic features, like the side wings protecting the cockpit, that have become a signature element of the brand. Four windows on each side of the hull, each with elliptical portholes, complete the design of this "fighter jet" on the water.

AFT AREA AND COCKPIT

The transom can be moved by means of an electro-hydraulic system that allows it into the water at various heights, up to approximately 60cm, simplifying the launching and hauling of the tender. The garage can be accessed from the beach area when the door is open, while the cockpit can be

reached via a few steps starboard of the garage door, or through a concealable gangway.

The cockpit is fitted with a large sundeck, headrest and a second sofa. The area can be separated or joined to the salon thanks to a special opening and closing system for the glass door and glazed surface that divides these two areas. The glazed surface above the cockpit can be electrically lifted, while the two sections of the glass door can be opened or closed separately: the upper one can be manually tilted toward the outdoor ceiling panel; the lower one opens into

the interiors, creating a partition between the salon and the cockpit and ensuring maximum safety when children are on board. This solution also allows for the deck to be transformed into an open area from bow to stern, or to separate the interior from the outside depending on the weather conditions.

MAIN DECK

A blend of essential design elements, lacquered frames and fabrics in soft grey shades, are interspersed with darker and contrasting details, characterizing the design of the living area.

The flooring is finished in a similar grey-tone oak and further incorporates the colors of the other materials used on board. It is present in all settings, except for the cabins. A warm and soothing atmosphere is created by the use of these colors, which is further enhanced by an abundance of natural light coming through the large windows on all four

sides. Or by the additional, indirect LED lighting installed in the ceiling, that can fully aluminate the interior, even at night. Beyond the dining and living area lies the plank, with a modern, sporty look designed by Besenzoni. Over the helm station is a large sliding glass roof. On the portside is another

LOWER DECK

The 5X is the first Pershing below 60 feet where the owner can enjoy a full-beam master suite with an ensuite bathroom and a dinette in front of the galley. A possible alternative is that the VIP cabin, equipped with bathroom that can be used as day head - and a dinette facing the galley.

All these stylistic solutions, designed by Fulvio de Simoni and Ferretti Group's Engineering Department, give the 5X its unique style. Lacquered elements, essentials, and pristine white Vescom wallpaper are used to decorate the sleeping suites. Bedspreads and cushions by Zimmer + Rhode and Casamance, in addition to a pair of decorative lamps by Cini & Nils in the master suite, complete the decoration of the first hull. The bathrooms, with ceramic top and basin, can be fur-

ther equipped with decorative mosaics on the shower walls. On the first unit that was presented in Cannes, the master bathroom featured a mosaic in light grey tones called "Pulsar Chrono" by Mosaico+. The kitchen's Cantalupi LED fixtures illuminate its beautiful Corian Anthrachite surface.

The same material is used on the table top of the dinette, which is built around a foldable table that is available upon request. Once unfolded and covered with a cushion, the "C-shaped" sofa is transformed into a comfortable sofa bed. Two additional fixtures by Fontana Arte complete the decorations of the lower deck. Upon the owner's request, the dinette can be replaced by a third cabin with bunk beds or a crew cabin. If the latter is selected, it can be accessed from the outside, through the deck, to ensure maximum privacy for guests.

ENGINE AND PERFORMANCE

The Pershing 5X is available in two engine configurations which also involve a different engine room arrangement. The owner can choose from twin VOLVO IPS950 D11 with 725hp with Z-drives and counter-rotating propellers (cruising speed of 30 knots, maximum speed of 36 knots - preliminary data).

Additional integrated solutions offered by Volvo can be installed on board. Alternatively, the owner may opt for twin CAT 12.9 engines, with 1,000 HP each, and Top System 75X surface drives (cruising speed 41 knots, maximum speed 45 knots - preliminary data), to which you can add the EASY-JET system that is usually reserved for larger vessels. Upon request, an optional joystick can be added which allows enhanced manoeuvrability. This system, available for the first time on a Pershing, is called EASY DOCK and is the result of the consolidated technological partnership between Pershing and Top System. The EASY DOCK system will be exclusively available on the new coupé and further development of the system is guarantee.

Pershing 5X is the revolutionary yacht that will satisfy the thrill in every yachting enthusiast. Let's anticipate the future!

Ferretti Yachts makes its comeback in the range under 50 feet with the new flybridge yacht.



tyle, comfort, class, performance, brightness, lounge areas out on the sea and sporty DNA: imagine these features at the very height of excellence and you will have the new Ferretti Yachts 450. Presented in late July at the private preview in Portopiccolo Sistiana, an exclusive marina a few miles from Trieste, the yacht was created to captivate enthusiasts and owners from all over the world. Ferretti Yachts 450 is the result of the collaboration between the Ferretti Group Product Strategy Committee, the Group's Engineering Department, which supervised the technical and naval engineering, and the Studio Zuccon International Project, which handled both exterior and interior design.

The flybridge yacht features sleek, dynamic lines which give this 45-footer the sporty feel that embodies the latest generation of Ferretti Yachts.

The three decks let you enjoy every moment on board, thanks to comfortable and extraordinarily bright interiors with glazed surfaces on main and lower decks.

The furnishings were developed by the Ferretti Group Engineering Department interior designers to create a refined, playful contrast between the variety of materials and colours.

This produces a sophisticated combination of woods, lacquered surfaces and fabrics that fuses a contemporary living style with a traditional marine design, a hallmark of the brand.

MAIN DECK

Once on board, the stern swimming platform featuring a tender lift offers a submerged area to use as a beach club or to move the tender (up to 2.80 metres). The cockpit is fitted with an aft sofa and a wooden table.

The interiors of the main deck are a streamlined open space, with a fully parquet floor. The galley on the port side features walnut furniture doors with lacquered frames and a glazed surface at the bottom. The worktop is made from innovative nanotechnology material. A leather upholstered cabinet on the starboard side contains a refrigerator and freezer. The central living area is fitted with a sofa on the port side surrounding the dining table, opposite which is a second sofa against the wall. The helm station is located at the far bow on the starboard side.

LOWER DECK

The lower deck of the first unit has a three cabin layout, accommodating up to 6 people.

The full-beam master suite is enhanced by the playful decorations of walnut, fabrics, lacquered surfaces and carpet in various shades of grey, as well as leather inserts in the furniture panels, framework and headboard. The captivating style of the suite also features extraordinary volume and space: indeed, the central double bed is flanked by a comfortable sofa on the starboard side and many storage compartments and by two spacious wardrobes stretching to other containers against the wall.

The master suite is completed by a large en-suite head with separate shower decorated by a mosaic wall.

A similar interior design distinguishes the VIP suite at the far bow, while the guest cabin features bunk beds on the starboard side.

The head with separate shower in the VIP suite is shared with the third cabin and can also be used as a day toilet.

FLYBRIDGE AND EXTERIORS

There is a surprising amount of space outside, starting from the flybridge which gives extra character to the yacht. The sundeck is divided into a dining area with central table and bar unit at the stern and a central outside pilot station. The compact design of the helm station, along with the storage of the life raft under the captain's seat, help create space





The windows in the hull are large and generous, while on deck the windows are floor to ceiling and create direct contact with the sea thanks to the pulpits which replace traditional gunwales.

MAIN DECK INTERIOR

The cockpit design is striking with its contemporary style, thanks to the innovative large window that is divided in two sections and can be opened separately. Developed in collaboration with a company active in the aviation industry, it has an inclination that draws inspiration of the screen of a tablet. Over the window, the area is set up as a "lounge" decorated with teak and furnished to the stylistic code the interior with a sofa by the adjustable backrest. The TV, coming down from the ceiling can rotate 180°.

Another prominent innovation is the elevation of the superstructure. This height difference, compared to the bridge, allows for an unparalleled view from the raised salon. The side windows, which are slightly curved, enhance the feeling of living close to the sea.

The concept is inspired by the luxury language of residential furnishing designs, offering:

- The support columns, which include lighting systems, audio and air conditioning;
- A single open space decorated with curtains;
- The large central living room, with large windows for panoramic views.

Besides accessing the formal dining area, the lobby exits on the walkway, where you can go below deck or continue to the Master suite. On the opposite side, you enter the pantry also accessible from the outside and then in the galley, from which you can go down in the crew area.

From the pantry, you can go up in the wheel house, which is furnished with sofas and a stern hatch to access the flybridge.

The wide body Master suite, with large windows, has a double bed on the left and a seating area on the starboard side. The bathroom has two sinks, double toilets and a central shower.

LOWER DECK

There are 4 guest cabins: 2 aft doubles feature a spectacular arrangement of beds, aimed at the side to enhance the view through the large hull windows. The 2 forward cabins have single beds to which you can add a pullman bed. All are equipped with an en-suite bathroom with separate shower.

The crew area at bow is fitted with a large dinette, captain's cabin with desk and private bathroom, hostess cabin and two double cabins for sailors, all with private bath and separate shower.

blend admirably on the upper deck, with the panoramic bridge for livability in total privacy. The protection offered by the side windows is integrated in the hard top with a sky light above the cocktail area, the lounge and helm station. The relaxation area, with hot tub and freestanding furniture, can be sheltered from the sun by a retractable bimini hard top supported by two poles integrated in the superstructure.

EXTERNAL BOW AND STERN AREAS

The patented DMT - Dual Mode Transom is implemented by the installation of two scuttles that when sailing, cover the rise to the cockpit steps allowing for maximum clean lines to the stern. As the ship comes to a halt, they disappear in the central part of the stern, allowing guests to access on board. From the garage down in the water, an up to 18 feet tender and a personal watercraft with three seats can be placed.

Another generous space in the bow can be accessed by the external stairs to the starboard side or through two doors in the flybridge, in correspondence the maneuver at the side stations.

Two separate sun pads create a walkway that leads to the extreme bow, which is fitted with a large dinette, sofa and table, under which a garage can house a second tender or a jetski.

TECHNOLOGY AND PERFORMANCE

Custom Line 120' installs a pair of MTU 16V 2000 M94 engines with 2638 mhp, reaching up to 22 knots cruising speed and 25 knots at top speed (preliminary data). Interesting is the speed of the economic cruising at 11 knots, which will provide a range exceeding 1,050 nautical miles (preliminary data). The highest level comfort at anchor is possible thanks to the standard installation of stabilizer fins with electro underway functionality and zero speed, and propeller in the bow thrusters. On request a second propeller at the stern and gyrostabilizers can be installed. Maximum attention is also given to sound proofing and reducing the impact of power units and generators during the stop at anchor: Custom Line 120 'has a floating floor and an additional insulation between bulkheads and ceilings. The integrated bridge was built along with Axon Marine by NAVIOP.

As always, the large technical area is well organized, divided between the engine room and Engine Control Room, that has air conditioning.

While drawing inspiration from and maintaining a family feeling with the 61m M/Y Saramour, the first superyacht built by CRN in cooperation with Architect Paszkowski, these new 72m and 80m yachts can rely on much larger volumes and introduce innovative architectural solutions.

"The Saramour was our first opportunity to cooperate with a prestigious shipyard like CRN and was a drive for us to jointly develop new, innovative ideas" - says Francesco Paszkowski - "These two projects are a natural evolution of the stylistic features of their 61m predecessor and the result of a deep analysis and an extensive research aimed at finding the perfect balance between outdoor and interior spaces".

The relationship with the surrounding elements - air and water - is a key feature in these yachts' concept, which has

been turned into reality by creating terraces overlooking the sea, outdoor swimming pools, wide glazed surfaces and, obviously, a spacious beach club (a distinctive element on CRN yachts) - all aiming at ensuring direct contact with the sea.



esigned to accommodate the owner's long wish-list of toys, both inside and out, the WIDER 165 will satisfy the desires of the most adventurous, with submarine and helipad included. A visit to the shipyard in Ancona shows that great progress has been made in developing the layout and herein lies one of the biggest differences between her and the smaller sistership, the WIDER 150.

The interior layout, designed by Ideaeltalia in conjunction with the owner's architect, is packed with more stand out features including a generous study with terrace on the port side, private gym with terrace on the starboard side, a sauna room as well as a spacious and light owner's bathroom.

On the foredeck, the helicopter-landing pad, unique to the WIDER 165, and circular seating areas set into the superstructure, forward of a large Jacuzzi tub, offer a versatile









space that will double as generous dance floor for fun evenings afloat. The stand out feature across the WIDER range is the inclusion of a generous Beach Club: the WIDER 165 has taken this even further to include a submarine as well as the WIDER 32 that we have seen on the WIDER 150.

The entire layout and decor of the vessel has been studied in minute detail to satisfy and exceed the owner's requirements but also clearly reflects the shipyard's desire to offer customized projects on standard platforms.


LOW-CONSUMPTION DIESEL ELECTRIC PROPULSION

The beating heart of the WIDER 165' project is its diesel electric propulsion system combined with a 544kWh Lithium polymer battery bank and Azimuthal pods, which guarantees hugely reduced fuel consumption.

Four inline variable speed diesel generators, controlled by the state-of-the-art WIDER power management system and the latest battery technology, serve the hotel and propulsion requirements of the vessel.

The traditional engine room has been replaced by a Power Generator Room, located in the bow. This leaves the mid ship of the vessel free for larger, more comfortable guest cabins located in the most stable part of the yacht. This ar-

rangement is only possible because of the use of Azimuthal pods which receive power through an electric cable unlike traditional propulsion systems which have shafts.

In addition to space gains, this combination of Diesel Electric combined with Lithium polymer battery banks and Azimuthal pods affords significant advantages compared to conventional shaft-line propulsion. These include:

- > increased reliability
- > fuel efficiency

- > greater range
- > shallow draft
- > lower noise and vibration
- > reduced maintenance
- > greater flexibility

The propulsion system is also completely modular, meaning the WIDER 165 can cruise using only the battery packs, in ZEM (Zero Emission Mode), or with up to four inline diesel







generators. When fully charged, the battery power is sufficient to power all of the hotel services, including air conditioning, for an overnight stay at anchor or while enjoying the beach in complete silence, with no engines running.

A range of 3,600nm is expected at a cruising speed of 13 knots, increasing to 5,600nm at the economical speed of 10 knots. The yacht has a maximum speed of 14.5 knots. Also available at Zero Emission Speed, the WIDER 165 can run solely on batteries for silent cruising at lower speeds (5 knots), or for short movements, avoiding the need to start generators to move anchorages or for early starts.

As with all of the WIDER Superyacht range, the onboard power sources are controlled by the WIDER Power Management System, a smart and fully integrated system which controls the power supplied by the shore connection, the gensets and the battery packs, distributing it between the hotel requirements, the propulsion system and the recharging of batteries, as required.

Our dedicated partner in this project, and the supplier of our WIDER Power Management system, is the marketleading, global powerhouse, Emerson Industrial Automation. Colors on the Wider 165 have been chosen meticulously to fit the overall mood.

ALL-ALUMINUM CONSTRUCTION

The yacht's intelligent design focuses on minimizing fuel consumption and emissions while maximizing onboard living space, without underestimating the importance of easy maintenance.

The material chosen for the entire construction of the WIDER 165 is aluminum, a noble, durable metal that, being particularly lightweight, makes it possible to increase the performance/consumption ratio of the yacht and hence achieve a considerable reduction in emissions.

Combined with the fact that aluminium is completely recyclable, this helps to reduce the vessel's footprint on the environment. Aluminium also provides greater freedom during construction as it increases the opportunity for customization, yet considerably shortens production times.

Thanks to the collaboration with the architects involved in the project, the interior design corresponds to WIDER's mission of enhancing the connection of the owner and guests to the water at all times through the use of large windows, side-opening balconies and spacious exterior dining and entertaining areas.

Architects at Ideaeltalia have worked closely with Tilli Antonelli in order to obtain very bright interior spaces combined with warm colors, linear and clean design matched with a perfect balance of wood, glass and leather together with some more ornate details linked to oriental culture, reflecting the taste and background of the owner.

The choice of materials used onboard are primarily deep sanded oak, roman travertine stone, premium quality leathers and Italian white marbles. These have been elegantly combined to give a contemporary styled interior with a distinct Italian flair. Among the many unique features on board the WIDER 165 are the owner's private terrace overlooking the sea, which opens off the full-beam master cabin. The sizeable guest quarters comprise four en-suite cabins on the lower deck






uperyacht designer Tony Castro worked closely with Gdansk builder Galeon to effectively implement the most appealing features of a superyacht into a much smaller boat.

On the rear half of the boat, for instance, the side gunwales fold down on both sides, and the salon walls open up, creating an al fresco bar on the port that connects directly to the interior galley. On the other side, the area becomes an open terrace where guests can sit in the interior salon lounge and look out over the water. 


INTERNATIONAL INSPIRATION FROM THE WORLD'S LEADING FAIRS

It's been a crazy year so far and we're taking solace and more than a little inspiration from the world's best design fairs by finding some of the most creative pieces from the four corners of the globe. Travel with Splendida and discover the best of the best from Milan, Dubai, Paris, Miami and London and Istanbul – to name a few.



MILAN SALONE DEL MOBILE

Milan's Salone del Mobile is without a doubt one of the most inspirational fairs on the Calender. This famous center of Italian culture brings together deisgners from all over the world and has launched the careers of countless talented creatives. This year we fell in love with Dolce & Gabbana's Limited Edition Fridge; inspired by the lemon groves, fruit and vegetables of Italian cuisine, the piece is manufactured by SMEG and retails for around 35,000 USD. Perfect, just perfect and replete with the emotions of an Italian kitchen, we love it.



DUBAI DESIGN WEEK

Dubai Design Week is one of the world's newest and most exciting events. Highlighting the creations of the local UAE art and design scene, the fair brings together regional artists and international names and helps to spread the news of Dubai's thriving design sector. Our highlight from Dubai was the Hexalite Installation, an outdoor piece by Emirati designer Zeinab Al Hashemi. Commissioned by Swarovski, the installation features geometric repetition created through the reflection of 33 Swarovski crystal structures. The specially coated crystals create a kaleidoscopic effect akin to a mirage. Hexalite just begs to be explored and invites viewers to explore how it changes their perception of light and color.



MAISON ET OBJET

Maison et Objet is one of those eternal classics that you just have to visit as often as you can. Paris' leading design event, it's just packed with design talent waiting to be discovered. Located in the Nord Villepinte, Maison et Objet is certainly a unique experience. Our favorite collection this time around was Marcel Wanders' Circus for Alessi. Bright, fun and full of classic imagery, it's a great series of tableware for those looking for something a little different. With a childlike sense of wonder, this collection is sure to brighten up any dining table.



DESIGN MIAMI

Design Miami is a global forum for design and each event brings together influential collectors, gallerists, designers, curators and critics. Occurring alongside the Art Basel Miami fair, Design Miami caters toward collecting, exhibiting, discussing and creating collectible design. This year we loved the Abyss Tables by Duffy Studio from London, an expansion of its popular Abyss range. The Abyss Dining Table is a conversation piece as much as a functional one and the design is concerned with depth, creating a geological cross-section as mesmerizing as the sea. Plexiglass and wood, the table is arranged like a 3-D representation of a geological map.



THE LONDON DESIGN FESTIVAL

The London Design Festival is made up of over 400 events and serves to promote the city's creativity, drawing in the world's greatest thinkers, practitioners, retailers and educators to a deliver an incredible celebration of design. It's a must for anyone truly interested in interior and product design. This year designer Mathieu Lehanneur installed a spectacular work from his Liquid Marble series. Made of a single piece of hand-polished black marble, Liquid Marble reproduces the visual effect of a sea's surface gently ruffled by the wind. The structure reflects and distorts itself, and the intense black of the marble accentuates the color of the ocean as if fossilized in stone.



THE ISTANBUL DESIGN BIENNIAL

The Istanbul Design Biennial ties together projects by international designers from all over the world. The latest collection was titled "Are We Human?: The Design of the Species: 2 seconds, 2 days, 2 years, 200 years, 200,000 Years. The multidisciplinary group, the work of a large group of international writers, video makers and designer researchers was presented across a number of venues and online to stimulate a new kind of conversation about design. Our highlight was Rana Salam Studio's pop up coffee shop hosted inside the Galata Greek Primary School where the Biennial was hosted. Visitors experienced another world where Beirut city was translated into a design experience through its architectural buildings, landscape and people.

BETWEEN MODERNITY AND CONTEMPORARY ART

SPLENDIDA BRINGS YOU AN EXPERT'S VIEW ON ART

As the international art markets become ever more complex, it's important to understand the nature of this fascinating arena. Here we speak to Pascal Odille, Artistic Director of Beirut Art Fair and Expert in Modern and Contemporary Art- member of the CNES (Chambre Nationale des Experts Spécialisés), France about the current state of the markets and the potential for the future.

rieze has just closed its doors and the results of the recent movement in the London art market is just beginning to become apparent. FIAC and the yearly Parisian fairs also play their part, in short, the European art market is moving. On top of all this we had Beirut Art Fair in September. It's a busy time and collectors the world over are looking for value in a contemporary market along with works from slightly further back, the 1960's in particular.

GREAT RESULTS FOR POST-WAR WORKS IN LONDON

London's two most famous auction houses announced the end of their season and posted excellent results with sales of 55 million USD for Christie's and 90 million USD for Sotheby's.

The record achieved by the young Romanian painter Adrian Ghenie, who's work sold for 9 million USD at Christie's (the high end estimate was set at 1.9 million USD), has raised many questions, more so as two days later, during an auction at Sotheby's, another work by the artist, but of a smaller size and from the



same period, did not appeal to buyers at an estimate of 200,000 USD. Adrian Ghenie had already surprised the market by managing a record of 4.5 million USD. On top of this oddity was the return to center stage of Damien Hirst, he was shunned by the market and managed to raise 844,000 USD at Christie's, a number which represents a dramatic decline from his earlier sales.

Sotheby's achieved great results by trading on safe market value, especially in the case of a Basquiat, which sold for more than 10,000 USD along with a Richter at the same price. The London market seems an odd place, effected no doubt by the falling value of the Pound Sterling.

THE NAVE OF THE GRAND PALAIS: TOWARDS MODERNITY

It has been a long time since the FIAC had enabled the Parisian public to see a significant collection of works of art from the modern period. On the walls of the galleries come together Picasso, Tanguy, Miro, Calder, Brauner, Louise Nevelson. Klein and Nikki de Saint Phalle. Recognized and hailed as great value propositions for many years, the works mix the history of art and art market perfectly. Recently, the interest of collectors seems to have turned outward, toward other countries when it comes to studies of modernity, including Japan through a strong comeback by the works of Tetsumi Kudo, who died in 1990. Upstairs, in the upper galleries of FIAC, we saw an entirely different approach, a carte blanche was given to discover the young international scene.

A STRONG LEBANESE PRESENCE AT FIAC

Lebanese artists also know how to seduce the French pub-

lic, Walid Raad, Joana Hadjithomas and Khalil Joreige, Simone Fattal and Etel Adnan were well represented on the walls of the FIAC and in many booths. The exhibitions paying tribute to Etel Adnan at the Arab World Institute in Paris and the one organized at the Serpentine Gallery in London last spring reflect a growing international interest in Lebanese artists.

THE LEBANESE MARKET IS NO EXCEPTION TO THIS TREND

On a smaller scale, this enthusiasm for modernity is also felt in the Lebanese market. It reflects the growing interest among Lebanese collectors for works that showcase their history and heritage. This enthusiasm is accentuated by the dynamism of collectors, who wish to share their discoveries and masterpieces from their collections with ever increasing numbers of people. Beyond highlighting modernity, Beirut Art Fair also has a role to play with regard to the young international scene, that's why we created Revealing, an exchange platform, where galleries and artists can interact directly with the public. In our last edition we discovered Adel Bentousi and Fella Tamzali (Algeria), Morteza Khosravi and Maryam Hoseini (Iran), Rafat Asad (Palestine), Ghader Saeed (Jordan) and Waseem Ahmed (Pakistan). As Jean-Marc Decrop said in his interview in Les Echos with Martine Robert, "More and more exhibitions are intended to be regional groupings... Thus, Art Dubai or Beirut Art Fair provide unusual sensations they are not the eternal Gormley, Prince, Hirst, Murakami ... Niche events have a different flavor. "

So, next year we invite you to Beirut Art Fair from 21 to 24 September 2017, come and discover this "different flavor".



ouse Of Today recently announced their third biennial exhibition, titled

Jungle Protocol tradition & etiquette set to take place in Beirut this December. House of Today, a non-profit organization, is recognized internationally as a reference for design in Lebanon. Founder Cherine Magrabi Tayeb has carefully extended the House of Today program over the last two years to include international tours of commissioned work, curated exhibits with Lebanese designers, and special commissions at global design events. The success of the curated exhibitions has allowed the continuation of House of Today's main purpose, which is to fund scholarships for young Lebanese designers.

As founder and curator of House of Today, Magrabi Tayeb has overseen the development of the House of Today program. Magrabi Tayeb identified the need for a platform for Lebanese design, one that would put Lebanon on the international design map, and set out to achieve this. Her skills as a businesswoman, managing a retail chain of 200 stores in the Middle East, and her commitment to the arts as a founding member of the Beirut Art Centre and council of the Serpentine Gallery in London, combine to make her a powerful force on the international cultural landscape and has been asked to curate special collections internationally.

In 2014, it's second exhibition Naked: Beyond the Social Mask, gained international acclaim and its success provided the opportunity for House of Today's scholarship program to fund 6 design scholarships to young Lebanese designers. It also provided a platform for House of Today's designers to work with international galleries such as Nilafur in Milan, Gallery Fumi in London and Carpenters Gallery in London and Paris.

In this exhibition, products designed by Lebanese creative will be on display alongside the launch of The Shop, a collection of home and office products in collaboration with WallpaperSTORE* and guest curator Nicolas Bellavance-Lecompte of Lebanon's Carwan Gallery. The designers were invited reflect on their own traditions and open their eyes to other cultures. Underneath a veneer of chaos and differences, there is an underlying order that binds us all together: Jungle Protocol.

Massimiliano Locatelli, from Italy and Norway's Snøhetta will contribute pieces alongside the following Lebanese designers: Flavie Audi, Stephanie Sayyar and Charbel Garibeh, Tessa and Tara Sakhi, Carla Baz, David Raffoul and Nicolas Moussallem, Georges Mohasseb, Nada Zeineh, Anastasia Nysten, Celine and Tatiana Stephan, Rabih Geha, Najla El Zein, Ranya Sarakbi and Niko Koronis, Khaled El Mays, Marc

THE MAN WHO DIVED INTO THE WRECK, CREATING A BOATING MIRACLE

3 YEARS OF ONGOING WORK ET VOILA, A BRAND NEW AQUARAMA IS REBORN!

So that's the ultimate Story of NADEGE: It was a dusty wreck forgotten in Sea Pros Yachts' warehouse, an old Aquarama Super with missing parts and a misplaced spirit. Mr. Micky Magnaghi proposed to adopt it and shipped it to the picturesque Lugano in Switzerland. Magnaghi, who is a Swiss-Italian citizen, grew up on a genuine passion for Rivas; his uncle owned a Tritone, his father an Aquarama and before that, both his father and uncle shared an Ariston in their early twenties. This incomparable passion for boats in a beautiful Swiss lakeside setting made this man a true hero as he refurbished a complete wreck and transformed it into a magnificent piece of art. After three years of work, Splendida met with Mr. Magnaghi in order to highlight the most significant aspects of this miraculous transformation.

The boat was basically a basket case, many parts were missing, the hull had been coated, the flanks had been planked and nailed on the beams with these latter having been modified in order to accommodate the clinker construction of the new side panels - the original ones having been removed in the process - the upper deck had undergone a faulty renovation attempt - However, despite the disastrous state of the boat, and somebody always up for a challenge, I knew I could probably put it right.

A refurbishing plan has been implemented to the exterior hull reaching the boat's mechanisms.











SP Were you obliged to rebuild structural elements or was it more like an external refurbishing?

The whole boat was too run down for a light cosmetic job so it had to be reconstructed starting with all the structural elements and the keel of course. We could only save 3 out of 40 ribs supporting the hull, the two longerons and a few bits and pieces – everything else had to be re-crafted anew from the original moulds. Of course the windshield and all the chromes fittings are the original ones. My aim in this core restoration (or quasi reconstruction if you prefer) was to rebuild the boat with a view to bring it back to as near as possible the same exact condition (structurally, technically & and aesthetically speaking) as when it had been sold 44 years ago by the Riva yard to its first owner.

SP What were the major steps of your refurbishing plan?

In terms of difficulty, first and foremost was finding the qualified people for the kind of work I had in mind – you don't have so many craftsmen in Italy anymore that have the necessary skills. Secondly I would say procuring the right woods and finally convincing the plywood manufacturer to craft the striped deck the way it was done 40 years ago.

SP What were the pleasures and pitfalls of the whole restoration process?

Well, seeing this endeavor gradually take shape was a major satisfaction. The only pitfall that I can think of was the reconstruction of the dashboard. We wasted two precious 'Cuban cedar' logs before we could get it right and eventually only managed on the third attempt.

SP You have transformed a total wreck into a piece of art, what was the best part of the restoration work?

I would say the learning process was quite rewarding and of course dealing with passionate and sometimes peculiar personalities was an interesting part of this adventure.

SP You have decided to leave the initial name on the boat along with the Lebanese flag, would you consider reselling the magnificent refurbished Aquarama to a Lebanese client?

Maybe one day but right now I'm too enamored with this boat to part with it so soon.





THAT'S HOW CHRISTO AND JEANNE-CLAUDE'S "THE FLOATING PIERS" MADE HISTORY.



A geographical masterpiece that has never been witnessed before.



ver 1,200,000 people visited Christo and Jeanne-Claude's The Floating Piers during its 16 days from June 18 through July 3, 2016. The temporary work of art featured fabric-covered piers 3 kilometers in length, constructed across the water of Italy's Lake Iseo, and continued along 2.5 kilometers of pedestrian streets in Sulzano and Peschiera Maraglio.

"Each project is a slice of our lives and something that I

will never forget," said Christo.

"Jeanne-Claude and I first conceived The Floating Piers in 1970. I later found Lake Iseo to be the most inspiring location to realize this project. The Lake's water, the landscape, and the communities around it have all been part of The Floating Piers. An important part of this project is the temporary part, it has a nomadic quality—this is why after 16 days it is gone."

The Floating Piers was free and accessible to the public, no tickets or reservations were required. Local authorities re-



The piers turned out a pure success, a hub that gathered visitors from around the world.



quested The Floating Piers close at night to accommodate the community of Monte Isola's sanitation needs.

On average over 72,000 people a day from around the world experienced The Floating Piers and explored the hosting communities around Lake Iseo, which offered food and drinks, and places for hikes where visitors could take in different vantage points of the piers.


"Monte Isola was 'Caput Mundi' [Capital of the World] for 16 days," said Fiorello Turla, Mayor of Monte Isola.

Christo financed the entire cost of The Floating Piers, approximately 18,000,000 Euros, including the assembly, installation, maintenance, security, and removal of the work of art.

The artist does not accept sponsorship. The total includes planned support for local 2 government agencies and host communities in the Lombardy Region, totaling 1,500,000 Euros. This funding covered services such as police, ambulances, fire personnel and for installation of telecommunications in the nearby tunnels. It also included concession fees for use of Lake Iseo and the communities of Sulzano and Monte Isola.

Additionally, during the project, Christo paid for extra

garbage removal, portable toilets, and other sanitation assistance for the surrounding area.

THE FLOATING PIERS INCLUDED:

> 220,000 high-density polyethylene cubes and pins, manufactured by four different companies in Northern Italy, used to create a modular floating dock system on Lake Iseo.

The cubes were re-granulated onsite and the material will be re-used in the plastics industry.

> 100,000 square meters of nylon fabric and 80,000 square meters of felt, from three companies in Germany, to cover 3 kilometers over the piers on water and 2.5 kilometers of pedestrian streets. The yellow-dahlia fabric as well as the felt underlay will be re-manufactured and used in the production of new fabric products.

The fabric may also be ground into a filler and used in such products as carpet underlayment.

> 200 concrete dead-weight anchors, weighing 5.5 tons each, specifically designed for the project. The anchors, used under water to hold the piers in place, were all carefully removed from the lakebed and milled/shredded for filler and industrial re-use.

Following the completion of The Floating Piers, Christo will return his focus to two works in progress he began with Jeanne-Claude; The Mastaba, Project for the United Arab Emirates, (started in 1977) and Over the River, Project for the Arkansas River (started in 1992).
